POLICE PERSONNEL WHO HAVE SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED PROBATION IN THE ENTRY CADRE WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR ATTENDING THE TEST, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT THEY SHOULD HAVE COMPLETED 5 YEARS OF TOTAL SERVICE AFTER THE DATE OF ADVICE OF KPSC OR 2 YEARS OF SERVICE AS CIVIL POLICE OFFICER WHICHEVER IS EARLIER.THE CPOs UNDER SUSPENSION, PENDING COMPLETION OF DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS ARE ALSO ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THE TEST, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT THEIR PROMOTION WILL BE MADE ONLY AFTER THE EXPIRY OF THE PERIOD OF SUCH REDUCTION IN TIME SCALE OF PAY OR THE COMPLETION OF THE DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AS THE CASE MAY BE (.) HENCE IT IS REQUESTED TO OBTAIN AND FORWARD THE APPLICATIONS FROM WILLING AND ELIGIBLE CPOs OF THRISSUR CITY DISTRICT, NOW WORKING IN THAT UNITS ON OR BEFORE 4PM 12-02-2020 IN THE ATTACHED PROFORMA. PAPER TO WHICH THE CANDIDATE WISH TO APPEAR MAY CLEARLY BE NOTED. BELATED APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

The General Head Constable's Test for the year 2020 will be held on 23.02.2020 as stipulated in Govt. order 1<sup>st</sup> cited and as amended from time to time. The test will be conducted as per detail: -

(A) Part I - Written Test (Papers I & II)

The Written Test (Paper I & II) shall be conducted at various Centers in the Districts, which will be arranged by the concerned District Police Chiefs. The Question papers and Answer Books for the Written Test (Paper I & II) will be supplied to the District Police Chiefs from Police Headquarters, according to the requirements.

(B) Part II - Drill Test

The Drill test will be conducted by the concerned District Police Chiefs on or before 15.02.2020 and results will be intimated to Police Headquarters by 20.02.2020, in name cover to Dy. Inspector General of Police (HQ), Police Headquarters.

The following guidelines with regard to the conduct of the General HC Test are issued with reference to the rules on the subject.

I. ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE THE TEST

(i) The police personnel who have satisfactorily completed probation in the entry cadre shall be eligible to attend the General Head Constables Test 2020, subject to the condition that they should have completed 5 years of total service after the date of advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission or 2 years of service as Civil Police Officer.

(ii) The eligible Civil Police Officers as stated above, who are under reduction in the time scale of pay or under suspension, pending completion of disciplinary proceedings shall be permitted to appear the test if they apply for it, subject to the condition that their promotion will be made only after the expiry of the period of such reduction in time scale of pay or the completion of the disciplinary proceedings as the case may be.

(iii) There will be not any revaluation for the Written Test

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## II. SUBJECTS FOR THE TEST

The subjects for the General Head Constables test will be as follows:-

### PART - I - WRITTEN TEST (Two Papers)

- Paper I : Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code and Evidence Act (Chapters I & II only)
- Paper II : Kerala Police Act, Police Standing Orders, Station Records and General Knowledge.(Special Local Laws, CCTNS, KP Forms etc)

Note:- *The question for the written test shall be such as to test the knowledge of candidates in elementary law and in the methods of application of statutory provisions in practical Police work. Knowledge of case Law and detailed knowledge of the laws of evidence are not expected.* [GO (MS) No.252/Home dated 17.5.1963]

### PART II - DRILL TEST

The Drill test shall consist of Drill with and without arms, Lathi Drill and Musketry, stress being laid on instructional ability.

Note: *A candidate who fails in any paper of the written test or in the Drill test may reappear for the particular test or paper in which he / she has failed. A candidate may also take the test separately for each paper of the written test and Drill Test. He / She need not take the test for the papers or drill already passed previously.*

## III. VENUE FOR THE TEST:

The venue for the test will be fixed by the concerned District Police Chiefs as the case may be for those CPOs borne on the establishment strength of the respective Districts. The CPOs in the Special Units or those on deputation to other departments (including the Vigilance Department) shall take the test at the Centers fixed in their parent Unit / District.

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**IV. WRITTEN TEST IN TAMIL & KANNADA**

Written Tests shall be conducted in Tamil and Kannada Languages also. The District Police Chief concerned will report to Police Headquarters at the earliest about the number of candidates who take the test in Tamil / Kannada Languages.

**V. INTIMATION REGARDING CONDUCT OF THE TEST TO CPOs INCLUDING THOSE ON DEPUTATION, LEAVE, SUSPENSION ETC. & SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION.**

It is the responsibility of the concerned District Police Chiefs to intimate all the eligible candidates sufficiently early about the conduct of the test. Such intimations should also be sent to the candidates on deputation, leave and to those under suspension. The applications received by the Special units should be sent immediately to the parent units of the applicant. In no case, the application should be sent to Police Headquarters. Wide publicity will be given regarding conduct of the test so that no candidates will lose his/her chance. The intimation about this may be displayed in the Notice Boards and circulated among the CPOs.

**VI. ARRANGEMENTS FOR PRINTING AND SUPPLY OF QUESTION PAPERS AND ANSWER BOOKS AND VALUATION OF ANSWER BOOK.**

**Question paper and Answer Books for the Written Test.**

Papers I & II will be arranged to be printed and supplied from Police Headquarters according to requirements. Valuation of the answer books will also be arranged by Police headquarters. The District Police Chiefs concerned should intimate Police Headquarters about the exact number of Question Papers and Answer Books (for Paper I & II) needed for the Written Test, before 13.02.2020.

**VII. DURATION OF THE WRITTEN TEST SHALL BE 2 HOURS AND 30 MINUTES FOR EACH PAPER. THE WRITTEN TESTS SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER.**

Paper - I : From 9.30 A.M to 12.00 P.M. (2 ½ Hrs)

Paper - II : From 2 P.M. to 4.30 P.M (2 ½ Hrs)

Test for both papers will be conducted on the same day.

With regard to the conduct of General Head Constable Test, the following instructions are also issued for strict compliance.

1. All District Police Chiefs are directed to complete the Preparatory Training Course before the end of this week and compliance report shall be furnished on or before 15.02.2020.
2. The test will be conducted under the personal supervision of the District Police Chiefs concerned and the test shall strictly be conducted under camera surveillance.
3. Invigilators shall be more vigilant at the time of the examination.

*There will not be any chance of postponement of the examination.*
